- All applications must be received by June 5, 2009
- A separate application must be submitted for each child
- Each application must include a \$5.00 application fee
- Camper interviews are required for individuals new to Wendt Center programs
 - Camper interviews are used to assess appropriateness and readiness for Camp
 - A scheduled appointment will be arranged for interviews
- Applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Space is limited so you are encouraged to complete and return your application as soon as possible

If your child is selected to participate in Camp Forget-Me-Not/Camp Erin DC, **you are required to attend the Parent Orientation on Saturday, July 18, 2009 from 10:00 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.** This is an opportunity to learn more about the Wendt Center for Loss and Healing, Camp Forget-Me-Not/ Camp Erin DC, and review the Camp schedule, transportation arrangements and expectations.
