Campers enjoy a full day of traditional camp activities and grief-focused workshops to help them explore a variety of ways to express themselves while developing skills in a safe, supportive environment. All the activities are specially designed to help campers express themselves and develop bonds with others. The Wendt Center believes that grief impacts the entire family system, therefore a portion of each session is dedicated to intentionally integrating caregivers and family members.







The individual attention that volunteers provide to campers is what makes Camp Forget-Me-Not/Camp Erin DC so special. Every child's self-expression is heard, valued, and honored. Professionally licensed therapists will lead several therapeutic group sessions designed to address the age-specific needs of grieving campers.
